



DID YOU KNOW?

When God describes God's self in Exodus the description we get is simply "I AM WHO I AM."

Not boy or girl, or old or young, or anything else that would describe a person.

That's because God's not a person, but a presence. That's a really big idea in a very small sentence!




Describe or draw yourself on the outline above - things you like to do, favorite things, hair colour, height, or anything else that explains who you are.

Now think about this: All of these things help to describe you, but they aren't even close to all of the things that make up who you are. When we talk about God we have to talk about smaller pictures so that we can understand even a little bit about a God who is big enough to create and care for everything.

SO WHAT EXACTLY IS A SIMILE?

A simile (sim-ah-lee) is a special word that helps to describe something by bringing an image to our minds for us to compare. The Bible uses these words, pictures and symbols a lot to help describe what our very big God is like in ways that we can understand. These descriptions can't possibly give us the whole picture of God, but they can help us to relate to God.
