so who was habakkuk?




Habakkuk (ha/back/uck) was one of the minor prophets whose writing appears in the Old Testament. Habakkuk asked big questions of God about why God would let bad things happen to people.

We often have questions like that when we feel disappointed or confused or hurt. But one of the coolest things we can learn from Habakkuk is that it's okay to ask God questions when we don't understand what is happening around us. His prayers tell us that even though God doesn't have to work exactly as we want him to we can still be patient and trust that God listens to us and loves us no matter what.

DID YOU KNOW?

Remember last week when we learned that God's thoughts and actions aren't exactly like ours (Isaiah 55:8-9)?

Even though we can't always see exactly what is happening around us, Habakkuk's prayer reminds us that we can still trust that God wilk keep His promises. The picture below might not look exactly like something we recognize but the lines and curves still form a design.
